



FIRST SWING CLINIC



2nd Scottish Golf Festival, incorporating FREE First Swing Clinics Monday 26 to Wednesday 28 March 2012

Disabled people of any age and their coaches/carers are invited to participate in our second Golf Festival.

The event will incorporate a First Swing Clinic, where golf lessons, tuition, catering and use of practice facilities will be provided FREE OF CHARGE, for beginners, novices and established golfers. The First Swing Clinic will run on Monday 26 and Tuesday 27 March and participants can come along for one or both days. Attendance on both days can if required, incorporate an overnight B&B accommodation package on Monday 26 March. The First Swing Clinics will take place at Cluny Clays, Cluny By Kirkcaldy, Fife KY2 6QU

For the more established players with recognised golf handicaps, the Golf Festival will incorporate three rounds of Order of Merit Championship golf, one 18-hole round per day on Monday 26 at St Michaels Golf Club and Tuesday 27 at Cluny Golf Centre, culminating on Wednesday 28 March at the Dukes Golf Course St Andrews. The cost for this 3-day package, which includes the First Swing Clinic, three rounds of golf, catering and two nights local B&B accommodation, is £65 for SDGP members and £80 for non-members.

* B&B accommodation can be provided at a nearby hotel (not for Fife participants), based on sharing a twin room as required. If a golfer has the essential requirement of a coach/caddie, they will also be accommodated. Transport to and from all venues is the responsibility of each participant. Golf carts and trolley provision and organisation are not incorporated into this event. Group applications for the First Swing Clinic should list all details overleaf. Golf Festival Entrants will automatically be entered into the First Swing Clinics.
